



A YEAR IN REVIEW

QUARTER 1

- **13th Anniversary Celebrated:** 1500 myLIFEspeaks staff, families, and community members gathered in praise, worship, and testimony, celebrating 13 years of God's Light shining through the darkness in Haiti.
- **Forever Homes Updated:** Through our Tim Tebow Foundation Partnership, two Forever Families moved into their permanent homes in Neply. Homes where 8 children will grow up surrounded by love, laughter, and lasting memories.
- **Leadership Training Launched:** We began Christian Leadership Training for all 10 Department Heads, equipping them to lead with faith and integrity.

QUARTER 2

- **Therapy Education Expanded:** LIFE Therapy became a training site for (12) 3-month interns from Haiti's FSRL University Program, investing in the next generation of Haitian therapists.
- **Healthcare Advanced:** The LIFE Clinic added new lab testing equipment, enabling faster results, more accurate diagnoses, and better treatment for all patients and families.
- **Community Garden Harvested:** Our Happy Grove community garden produced an abundant harvest, providing enough food to bless all Forever Families, staff, feeding program participants, and elderly friends: over 4000 pounds of food.

QUARTER 3

- **Family Care Model Shared:** Our Family Empowerment Director and team traveled to Jacmel, Haiti, training another organization in family-based care and the inclusion of children of all abilities.
- **Parent Support Grows:** Bél Ewo (Beautiful Hero), our parent support group, grew by over 15% as more moms and dads came to learn biblical parenting principles, find encouragement, and live LIFE together.
- **Clean Water Provided:** A new well was completed for LIFE Academy, providing clean water for students, families, and the entire community, just in time for the new school year.

QUARTER 4 (CURRENT)

- **LIFE Academy Expands:** The school year opened with 55 Special Needs students and 320 students (Pre-K 3 through 9th grade), and our first-ever high school class! Teachers, students, and parents began the year in prayer, praising God for His continued provision and purpose.
- **Strategic Planning Advanced:** All 10 Department Heads completed in-depth surveys guided by our Board to help shape myLIFEspeaks' strategic plan for 2026 and beyond.



THE STORY OF CHRIST-SHMILEY

When Christ-Shmiley was born, his young mother, who also lives with special needs, struggled to give him the consistent care he needed. It was a hard beginning for their family, but God had already placed someone close by who would step in with love and purpose. Davidson, one of the social workers at myLIFEspeaks and Shmiley's uncle, came to the administration not looking for a handout, but for resources to help support his family and give them a chance to thrive together.

Through that simple act of courage and faith, God began to move. Shmiley was first seen at the LIFE Clinic, then evaluated and welcomed into LIFE Therapy where he began receiving both physical therapy and occupational therapy to help him grow stronger each week. His mother and grandmother joined Bél Ewo ("Beautiful Hero"), our parent support program, where they found encouragement, community, and practical tools to care for him at home.

One of the first blessings was a special chair provided through myLIFEspeaks. Before that, Shmiley spent much of his day lying on the floor. Now, he sits upright and comfortable, smiling from ear to ear. This is a simple reminder of God's goodness in motion.

As he continues to grow and gain strength through therapy, Shmiley will soon have the opportunity to attend LIFE Academy where he can learn alongside other children in the community. His future is filled with possibilities because his family was given the support they needed to stay together.

This is the heart of myLIFEspeaks: keeping families together and showing them that they are not alone. God created Christ-Shmiley in His image, for this family and for this moment. Through the resources provided by myLIFEspeaks, made possible because of generous donors like YOU, families like Christ-Shmiley's are being strengthened, empowered, and forever changed.


